



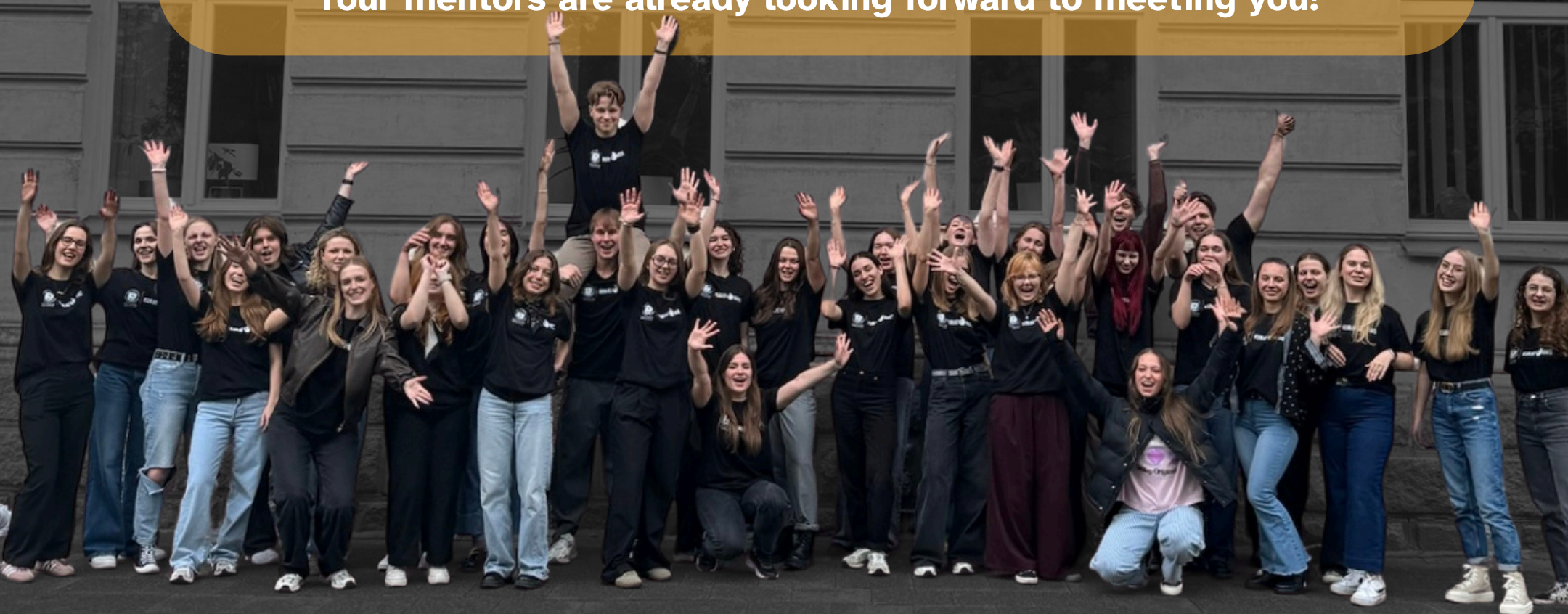

Accommodations in Vilnius

VILNIUS UNIVERSITY DORMITORY

Private apartments

International students mostly use Aruodas. You can also check Facebook groups (Foreigners in Vilnius; IknowflatinVilnius). Read the contract carefully and ensure all terms are clear and obtain the owner's explicit permission to declare your residency at that address.

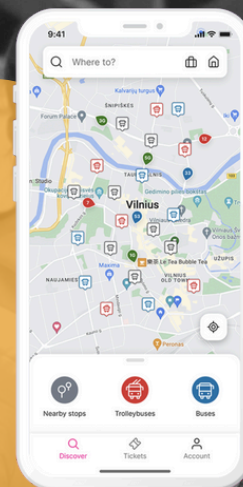


Living in Vilnius

Apps, suitable for using public transit in Vilnius:

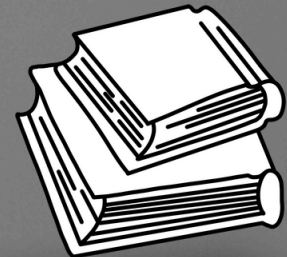
- **Trafi** (tickets and timetables)
- m.Ticket (tickets, but only in Lithuanian language)

You can also get a “JUDU kortelė” from “Narvesen” and activate your ticket in bus.



VU and Vilnius city libraries

VU Faculty of Medicine Library (M. K. Čiurlionio g. 21, ground floor) - 24/7. LSP is required to enter the library after 9pm. The main place to find literature of the medical field.



MKIC (Saulėtekio al. 5) - 24/7*, However an LSP is required to enter the premises between 9pm and 9am. This is the biggest study area in the university. Moreover, it has a number of personal study rooms to reserve for oneself for free.

VU Central Library (Universiteto g. 3) - consists of multiple reading rooms. Open at 9am - 9pm on weekdays (some reading rooms close sooner), and 9 am - 4 pm on Saturdays. LSP is always required to enter the library. Premises are not extremely big, but they are very cozy.

The National Library of Martynas Mažvydas (Gedimino pr. 51), open 10 am - 9 pm on weekdays and 10 am - 6 pm on weekends.

Get the contact details of your mentors and always know where to ask questions, if needed



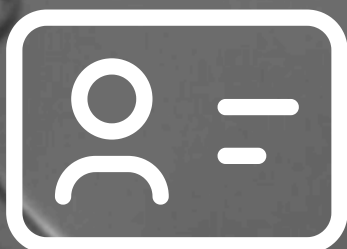

Student ID

- We encourage you to order your Student ID (LSP) as soon as possible!
- The LSP **is required** for taking exams and colloquiums, using the Vilnius University library, and accessing VU's internal information system.
- Public transport discounts and other student benefits are here.
- The LSP includes the European Student Card, valid in all European countries.



The ISIC card proves your academic status in Lithuania and 130 other countries worldwide.

**But you still need LSP!*

Students with an ISIC card can use their virtual card as well.

VU Identity management

A student who has started their studies at Vilnius University must register in the VU Identity Management System at <https://id.vu.lt/> by clicking on the "REGISTER" button



For registration you need to know your student ID (LSP) number.

When you sign up in the e-Identity Management System ID.VU.LT, it provides the following e-services:

- VU e-mail address and mailbox
- Access to VU IS Studies Virtual Student Workstation eStudent
- Permission to connect to VU VPN
- Permission to connect to wireless network eduroam
- Access to shared computers

Personalised email mailboxes in VU Office 365 cloud



All VU students are provided with spacious (100 GB) personalized email mailboxes in the VU Office 365 cloud (accessible via office365.vu.lt).

VU students are granted access to the Office 365 application package, which includes Word, Excel, PowerPoint, OneNote, Outlook, and more.

Office 365 can be installed by logging in to the student's Office 365 account.

VU IS eServices system

By logging into VU eServices system you can:

- Find out what your group in the new study program will be, find study schedules, exam grades, and your ranking among the top-performing students;
- choose elective optional and individual study courses;
- print tuition fee invoices;
- submit various applications;
- fill semester surveys!

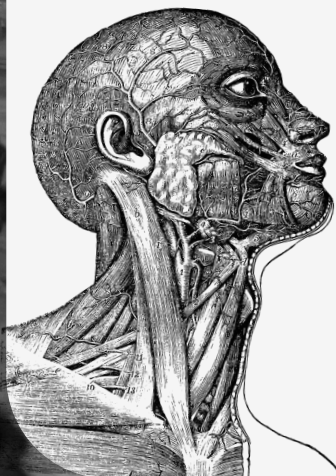
VU VPN



A computer network service provided by the VU Information Technology Services Centre. This is convenient when you want to use services or systems that are only accessible from the VU computer network.

Provides access to the VU Library's [subscription databases](#):



- **Complete Anatomy** - a 3D atlas of anatomy accessible via a mobile app;
- **ClinicalKey** - a medical information retrieval system providing access to Elsevier's medical and surgical content;
- **Access Medicine** - textbooks, interactive learning modules, information on diagnostic tests and differential diagnosis, and a database of drugs;
- **PubMed** - an archive of publications in the biomedical and life science fields;
- **MEDLINE** - a bibliographic database of topics in medicine and health sciences.

—First lecture of a course (module)—

The first lecture of a course unit (module) is very important. During the lecture, the lecturer must present a detailed description of the course unit (module), which will be followed throughout the semester:

- The syllabus of the course unit (module);
- The form and procedure of assessments and examination;
- The assessment criteria;
- The requirements to be allowed to take the examination;
- The list of required literature;
- The information presented during the first lecture cannot be changed during the semester;
- The description of the subject/module is published in the VU information system.

Tuition fee

The subsequent payments must be done before the end of the first month of the corresponding semester.

You may be allowed to pay tuition fees in instalments or postpone the payment of a tuition fee. Applications must be submitted via eStudent environment.

Incentive scholarships

Merit-based scholarships for high-achieving students are awarded and disbursed twice per academic year - at the beginning of the autumn and spring semesters, following the completion of the academic performance ranking process for the previous semester.

The amount of the incentive scholarship per semester is 11 BSI. The BSI (Basic Social Benefit) is a state-determined value, currently set at €70.00 per month.

This scholarship is awarded automatically, no application is required.

VU scholarships

- **Incentive Scholarship** - for particularly good academic performance;
- **Community Support Scholarship** - in the event of the death of a loved one, a natural or other disaster, illness or other similar event (criteria);
- **Community Service Scholarship** - for individual achievements that contribute to the future of society;
- **Scholarship for sporting achievements** - for those who have been particularly active in sporting activities of the University's sports teams or in individual sports, sporting achievements on behalf of the University;
- **Scholarship for scientific achievements** - for students who have been distinguished by their mature scientific activity.

VU parking

Free parking lots relevant for VU FM students:

- **M. K. Čiurlionio St. 21/27** (Faculty of Medicine / Dormitory parking lots)
- **Saulėtekio Ave. 9** (VU Information Technology Service Center), convenient for parking when coming for exams / assessments
