

INTRODUCTION

Grammar for Science Students is intended for intermediate and upper-intermediate students of sciences. The book is designed for use in class or self-study. It revises basic grammar structures students have difficulty with.

The grammar consists of 7 books, each of which focuses on particular points of grammar. Each book includes explanations and examples followed by a number of various exercises practicing the phenomena presented. The answers can be checked in the key available at the end of the books.

Book *Conjunctions, Prepositions etc.* mainly focuses on the needs of science students who attempt at building their writing skills as part of their academic curriculum. It includes such function words as conjunctions, prepositions as well as the most common suffixes and prefixes for word building. The book teaches how to make a piece of writing more effective and interesting connecting the ideas logically so that they can be easily followed and understood: it teaches to join clauses together by means of appropriate linkers, to combine the sentences within a paragraph using the appropriate transition words as well as to ensure coherence and logical relationship between the paragraphs. The choice and the aim of the selection is based on the frequency of usage of these function words in the academic prose without any intention to consider the lists presented complete.

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
